REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS

INSTRUMENTAL AWARDS

For students in grades 10, 11, or 12

Ruth and Sidney Salzman Award for Strings
Helen and George Greer Award for Instrumentalists
(Brass, Woodwinds, Percussion, Harp, Guitar)
Mildred and Julius Ness Award for Piano

- One composition for solo instrument and orchestra (memorization is encouraged but not required).
- One contrasting piece (solo or collaborative).
- 15-minute-maximum audition time.

VOCAL AWARDS

For students in grades 11 or 12

Nobel Hirsh Award for Male Vocalists
Tessa Martin Award for Female Vocalists

- Three contrasting songs in their original language (all music must be memorized).
- 15-minute-maximum audition time.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Aldridge-Tinker Scholarship for Instrumentalists
For students in grades 10, 11, or 12
Jan DeGaetani Scholarship for Vocalists
For students in grades 11 or 12

GRAND PRIZE

One candidate will be selected in the Final Round for the opportunity to perform with the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra.

Winners of the awards and scholarships will be invited to play or sing in a recital in Kilbourn Hall.

AWARDS AUDITIONS – FIRST ROUND

Young Artist Auditions for the Instrumental and Vocal Awards will be held from **8:00 am-1:00 pm**.

FINAL ROUND

The winners and runners-up of the Awards will perform the same program in a Final Round in the afternoon for a panel of judges who will choose the two Scholarship winners and the one Grand Prize winner.

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

All contestants must reside or study music in one of these New York State counties: Monroe, Genesee, Livingston, Orleans, Ontario, Seneca, Wayne, Wyoming, or Yates.

Previous winners are ineligible to compete for the same award.

Contestants must provide a legal version of each composition for the judges.

Piano accompaniment is required, and applicants must provide their own pianist.

A pianist may accompany a maximum of 5 students in the Award auditions.

Accompanists must be available for the Final Round if their student becomes eligible to compete.

All auditions are closed to the public.

APPLICATION FEE and DEADLINE

A non-refundable fee of \$50 must be submitted with each application.
